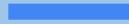

- **Four days of tryouts**
 - 8/11, 8/12, 8/13, 8/14
 - Participation is mandatory to be considered for varsity
 - Participation is strongly encouraged for all other squad decisions
- **Tryout Location**
 - Jefferson Grass Fields*
- **Tryout Equipment**
 - Cleats, running shoes, shin guards, water bottle
- **After EACH day...**
 - Pay attention to email and website for updated groupings
- **Roster Decisions Made on 8/14**
- **Two sessions each day - 10:30 to 12:30 and 4:00 to 6:00**
- **Day 1**
 - Shuttle Run
 - 1v1's, 3v3's, 11v11's
- **Day 2**
 - Intervals
 - 2v2's, 7v7's, 11v11's
- **Day 3**
 - 3200m run
 - 7v7's, 11v11's
- **Day 4**
 - 11v11's
